

## About us

The purpose of the Show Society Foundation is to support agricultural education and encourage individuals to pursue careers in primary industries.

Established in 2007, the Foundation provides scholarships, grants, bursaries and prizes covering all levels of education, with the aim of developing knowledge and skills in primary industry for the benefit of South Australia.

Scholarship recipients are encouraged to become involved in the activities of the Society, and to undertake promotional activities to inform the South Australian community about the importance of primary industry to the economy and social fabric of the State.

Since inception, the Foundation has distributed over \$705,000 to South Australian agricultural education initiatives, including directly supporting more than 40 individual young people into tertiary studies.

Urrbrae Agricultural High School Principal, Joslyn Fox, advises that these scholarships are imperative to the growth of the sector and success of the next generation:

"The scholarships provide an incentive to follow an agricultural pathway. They give students the opportunity to do things they would not otherwise think of doing. Agriculture now has changed so much with technology. The opportunities in farming today are far greater than ever before."
